



# Argentina

### The name Argentina

It comes from the Latin term "argentum", which means silver. The origin of this name goes back to the first voyages made by the Spanish conquerors to the Río de la Plata. The survivors of the shipwrecked expedition mounted by Juan Díaz de Solís found indigenous people in the region who gave them silver objects as presents. The news about the legendary Sierra del Plata - a mountain rich in silver - reached Spain around 1524. As from this date, the Portuguese named the river of Solís, Río de la Plata (River of Silver). Two years later the Spanish used the same name. The National Constitution adopted in 1853 included the name "República Argentina" (Argentine Republic) among the official names to designate the government and the country's territory.

### Location, area and frontiers

Argentina consists of 23 provinces plus a federal district, the City of Buenos Aires. Located in South America, and thus, in the southern hemisphere, the Country has an area of almost 3.8 million square kilometers, 2.8 on the continent – approximately 54% are plains (grasslands and savannahs), 23% plateaus, and the other 23%, mountains - and the remainder in the Antarctic. It is 3,800 Km. long and is located between latitude 22° and 55°. Its border with Uruguay, Brazil, Paraguay, Bolivia and Chile has a perimeter of 9,376 Km, while the territory bordered by the Atlantic Ocean is 4,725 Km long.

### Geography

Argentina's main characteristic is the enormous contrast between the immense eastern plains and the impressive Andes mountain range to the west. This is the frontier with Chile and boasts the highest peak in the Western hemisphere: the 6,959 m high Aconcagua Mt. From **Jujuy** to **Tierra del Fuego**, the Andes present marvelous contrasts: the Northwest plateaus, the lake region, the forests and gla-

ciers in the **Patagonia**.


To the north, Chaco is a forested area linked to rivers Bermejo, Salado and Pilcomayo. Between the Paraná and Uruguay rivers, the Argentine Mesopotamia (provinces of Entre Ríos, Corrientes and **Misiones**) is formed by low hills, where pools and marshlands evidence the ancient courses of these great rivers. In some places within the subtropical rain forest, there are fissures which provide such spectacular phenomena as the **Iguazú Falls**.

**The Pampas**, in the center of Argentina, is the largest and best-known area of plains. Agricultural and livestock activities are performed in this area, which includes the province of **Buenos Aires**, the northeast of La Pampa, the south of Córdoba and south of Santa Fe. To the south, the plains give way to small hills in Tandil and de la Ventana, and to the west, to the Córdoba hills.

Towards the south, from the Andes to the sea, appear the sterile and stony plateaus of **Patagonia**, swept by the wind during most of the year. The Atlantic coast, lined with high cliffs, forms massive indentations like the **Península Valdés**, with its spectacular and unique colonies of sea animals.


### Population

Argentina's current population is more than 36 million inhabitants, almost half of which lives in the city and the province of Buenos Aires. Population density calculated on a national basis is 13 inhabitants per square kilometer. 95% of the population is white and most are descendants of Italians and Spaniards. As a result of the massive European immigration, the white and Indian half-castes were slowly reduced and at the present they amount only to 4.5% of the population. The pure indigenous population - Mapuches, Collas, Tobas, Matacos and Chiriguanos - amount to 0.5% of the population.

# A Practical Guide to Argentina



## The Country

**ARGENTINA**, the country with every imaginable climate and landscape, dazzles by the marvels of its nature, like the **Iguazú Falls** in the Mesopotamia, the **Perito Moreno Glacier** in the Patagonia or the **Calchaquies Valleys** and the Puna in the Northwest. Argentina's main characteristic is the contrast between the plains and the Cordillera de los Andes. The highest peak of the Western Hemisphere is the Aconcagua -6960 meters-, located in the ARGENTINA Andes.

**The Andes**, from Tierra del Fuego to Jujuy, provides very different landscapes: extremely arid areas in the Altiplano, valleys, canyons and coloured hills, virgin woods and white glaciers in the Patagonia. Green hillocks, lagoons and marshes in the Mesopotamia that follow the ancient trace of the Paraná and the Uruguay Rivers. The exuberant Iguazú Falls surprise us in the middle of the subtropical forest.

**The Argentinian Pampas**, in the centre of the country, are the largest and most famous plains. In the south of the country from the Andes to the sea, lie the sterile and rocky plateau of the Patagonia, constantly flogged by the wind. The Atlantic littoral, skirted by high cliffs, has a sinuous shape, like **Península Valdés** that is a refuge for marine animals.

## National emblems



The Argentine flag has three horizontal stripes: the one in the middle is white and bears the golden sun, and the two outside stripes are light blue. The national flower is the ceibo, and the national stone is the manganese spar (rodocrosita) or "Inca Rose".

## Climate

The country's territory offers a wide variety of climates: subtropical in the North, sub-Antarctic in the southern Patagonia, and mild and humid in the Pampas plains. Media temperature from November to March is 23°C, and 12°C from June to September. In Buenos Aires, the capital, is mild and very humid. Winters are not so cold, and temperatures vary from 5 to 8 degrees centigrade. At night and early in the morning, it freezes and it is usually foggy and misty.

## Seasons / When to Travel

**Seasons:** in the southern hemisphere seasons are the opposite to those in the northern hemisphere.

**Summer:** from December to March 21th. Autumn: from March to Jun 21th.

**Winter:** from June to September 21th.

**Spring:** from September to December 21th.

**When to Travel:** Spring and Summer are the best months to visit Patagonia and the Southern Andes because of the mild temperatures and long days. Wintertime is recommended for travelling to the North and Northwest as rains are less frequent and tropical temperatures drop a few degrees. Autumn and spring are marvelous in Buenos Aires and Cuyo (Mendoza and San Juan). Anytime to visit Iguazu' Falls or Bariloche (Andes Mountains, in Patagonia).

## Getting to Argentina

### By Plane

All airlines flying to Argentina arrive at Ministro Pistarini (Ezeiza) International Airport, which is 35 Km away from the City of Buenos Aires. You can reach the city by Ricchieri motorway, and the trip takes approximately 40 minutes. There are also bus, taxis and chauffeur-driven rented cars. It is also possible to arrive at the cities of Cordoba and Mendoza by air from some bordering countries. Or even, you can reach Argentina by overland transport from these countries. Please note that when leaving the country, an airport tax must be paid.

## Getting around

Due to the country's large size, planes are best to travel long distances, and then you can take overland transportation to get to your final destination. Modern national airlines serve all the principal cities on a daily basis. Domestic flights and flights to Uruguay depart from Jorge Newbery Airport (Aeroparque), located to the north of the city besides the Río de la Plata.

## By Bus

Long-distance buses serve all the major cities, intermediate towns, as well as international destinations. They are comfortable and well-equipped with toilets, air conditioning, bar and hostess service.

## By Train

Train passengers service is available but is very slow, not very comfortable and often unreliable. However, Tourist Trains such as, the "Train to the Clouds" (North West), the "Train of the End of the World" (Ushuaia), the "Coast Train" (Buenos Aires outskirts) and other historical trains (Old Patagonian Express, Train of the Hills, etc.)

## By Car (Car rental)

All international car rental companies operate in Argentina. Is a comfortable option for the independent traveler. Requirements may vary depending on companies, usually 25 years of age, international driver's license and credit card are mandatory.

## The Underground System

In Buenos Aires (founded in 1913, was the first subway of Latin America), is one of the quickest ways of traveling within the city. This system currently comprises around 46 km, includes 80 stations. Services operate from 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM Monday through Saturday and 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM on Sundays. Tickets or passes are purchased in the subway stations.

## Taxis

There are 32.000 taxis within the city of Buenos Aires. They are painted in yellow and black. The exact fare is displayed on an electronic meter. There are many radio-taxis companies. They are ordered by telephone and pick up passengers anywhere. They do not charge extra and they are safer depending on the hour and the place. The remise is a similar service to the radio-taxi, only that the cars have no markings and they calculate the fare based on the distance.

## Time Difference / Electricity

The official Argentine hour is 3 (three) hours less than Greenwich Meridian. Electricity used is 220V (volts) and 50Hz (Hertz).

## Immigration Requirements

Valid passport with or without visa depending on your nationality. Inquire at the closest Embassy or Consulate. Tourists from abroad can stay in the country up to 90 days at most. Visitors coming from countries not bordering Argentina are exempt from all taxes on traveling articles and new articles up to US\$ 300 and an additional US\$ 300, if purchased at duty free shops within the national territory.

## Health

There is NO special health risk and NO vaccination certificate is required to enter the country, except for passengers coming from countries where cholera and yellow fever are endemic. Take normal precautions when drinking water, raw vegetables and shellfish. Altitude sickness generally is only a problem in the northern Altiplano. Best prevention's are gradual acclimatization, light meals and lots of liquids.

## Language

Spanish is the official language. In Buenos Aires, some "lunfardo" expressions -city slang - are used. However, if you speak English or Portuguese or Italian, you won't have any problems in getting around.

## Currency

The official Argentine currency is the Peso argentino. There are bills of 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, and 100 pesos, and coins of 1 peso, 50, 25, 10, and 5 cents.

## Telephone

Pay phones work with cards that may be purchased at kiosks and telephone companies' offices, or with legal tender coins. There are also stores with pay phones (open 24 hours a day) where you can pay with cash.

Calling to Argentina from abroad, dial the **country code (54)** and then the area code of the place you want to call (phone numbers located in the city of Buenos Aires, you must add the **local code (1)**).



## Shopping

**VAT return.** At the airport you may obtain a VAT reimbursement corresponding to any purchases made within the country for an amount over u\$s 70 (per invoice) and in shops operating with the "Global Refund" system. **Shopping is very convenient** overall the country and the products are of a very good quality. The high rate of exchange (Peso/U.S. Dollar) has turned Argentina (and Buenos Aires principally) into an excellent destination to purchase premium products at incredible prices: Fine leather goods - Shoes & Bags - Handcrafts - Antiques - Jewelry - Sports Products - Elegant Dresses - Rhodochrosite ms - etc.

## Payment Methods

Although US Dollars and Euros are generally

taken everywhere (bank notes must be clean, not signed or broken) foreign currencies can be exchanged in banks and authorized bureaus. Automatic tellers are numerous around the city. They may be used to obtain cash through the major credit cards like American Express, VISA, Diners and Master Card, that are widely accepted. Please note that there may be difficulties in changing traveler's check outside Buenos Aires. On tour is better to have cash.

## Opening Hours

**Banks and Exchange Bureaus:** Mondays to Fridays from 10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.

**Business Offices:** generally from 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. and from 2.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.

**Stores:** in the big cities from 9.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m., although in the outskirts and the provinces they generally close at midday. Saturdays, from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

**Shopping Centers** stay open every day until late hours.

**Bars, Cafés, and Pizza shops:** are opened most of the time except between 2.00 and 6.00 a.m.

**Restaurants:** lunch is served from 12.30 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. and dinner from 8.30 p.m. to 11.30p.m.

**Fast-food** menus are served in many restaurants at all times.

**Discos:** Open between 11.30p.m. and 1.00a.m. in the morning. They close at Dawn.

## Tips

10% of the amount of the bill is usually left in cafeterias and restaurants. Guides, doormen and porters are also generally tipped.

## Meals & Drinks

The typical Argentine food is the **ASADO** (barbecue: meat cooked over live coals), apart from empanadas (a sort of turnover meat pie or pastry that comes with a variety of other stuffings), tamales (a dish made of corn meal, chicken or meat wrapped in corn husks), humita (dish made of grated corn, sweet peppers and tomatoes wrapped in the green leaves of corn)

and locro (dish made of meat, potato, pumpkin, corn and sweet pepper).

Our country characteristic drink is the **MATE** (infusion).

The quality of its **WINES** and **MEATS** is worldly known and the new Argentine cuisine has reached an international level standing out due to its qualified chefs.

However, and due to the migrating current that populated the country, there is an important influence of international cuisine: Spanish, Italian, French, German, Scandinavian, Greek, English, Irish, Swedish, Hungarian, Dutch, Chilean, Mexican, Basque, Jewish, Russian, Ukranian, Chinese, Japanese, Thai and Arabians.

## Clothing

During **Summer** light, preferably comfortable and casual clothes are a must, but a light jacket is recommended specially if traveling up North or down to the Lake District or the Atlantic Patagonia, where evening might get cooler. During **Winter**, in Southern Patagonia it is always advisable to take woolen clothes, a parka, gloves and soft hiking or trekking boots.

## BA's Cultural Life

The city of Buenos Aires, the big Capital of Argentina, astonishes the tourist with its evident universal influence. Its numberless museums, exhibition and conference centers, art galleries, cinemas and theatres with national and international spectacles, are witnesses of its important cultural life.

**The Colon Theatre**, one of the most important lyrical theatres in the world, is seat, together with some other scenaries, of an intense musical activity that comprises all genres including, of course, the famous and typical Tango; besides, the city is frequently visited by orchestras, groups and soloists from all over the world.

## BA at Night

An intense and varied nightlife that lasts until really late. That is why it is known as "**the city that never sleeps**". Different areas of the city share the same characteristic: The possibility to dine until late at night and the promise to discover a world of sensations. Las Cañitas neighborhood, located 20 minutes from downtown, propounds a circuit of fashionable restaurants. Nearby is Palermo Hollywood neighborhood, where everything is vanguardist. On the other side of the city, just by the river, stands Puerto Madero with its first rate restaurants and excellent chefs. Ideal spot for summer nights. As for dancing and drinks till dawn, choices are for all styles and tastes. Recoleta, the heart of the city, the most elegant zone, with its restaurants, bars & Cinema complex.

## Buenos Aires City

The capital of the country and one of the ten most populated of the world, has 48 neighborhoods in an area of 200 sq. km. Its natural borders are the Rio de la Plata (River of Silver) and the "Riachuelo" (The Brook). Its climate is temperate and humid.

The charrúa Indians set up in these lands until the arrival of the first Spaniard Juan de Solís in 1516, who named the Río de la Plata, (River of Silver). But in 1580, Juan de Garay led the second and final foundation of the city. In colonial times, Buenos Aires was an important commercial center and almost all European ships arrived there. Its historical center shows the contrasts of a big city. Past and present melt when one sees its religious temples, monumental buildings and recycled houses.

**Buenos Aires** is still an important international center for commerce and tourism, the beginning of the End of the World. A colorful and **lively** cosmopolitan metropolis of truly international stature. The **glamour** and **elegance** of its European roots and its undeniable Latin American essence will fascinate any visitor.

Its vibrant **Tango** music, **good food** (meat & wine), its outstanding architecture, varied parks, exclusive boutiques and



# Tango Culture

“The gust, the Tango, that devilry”

Jorge Luis Borges, Argentine writer

“A sad thought that dances”

Armando Discépolo, popular poet.

Towards the end of the 19th Century, following the wave of European immigrants into Argentina, there was a gradual consolidation of rural and urban music by the citizens of Buenos Aires. Combined with African-based rhythms, these dances, formerly known as Candombe, performed by native black people in the Rio de la Plata region, gradually evolved into the Milonga.

Milongas were also places, houses where Tango was danced. The word “tango” signifies the sound of various instruments, such as the tambourine. At first, this new music was rejected by society. The dancers (in the beginning only men) performed mostly in questionable neighborhoods and often in house of ill repute. However, with the assistance of poets and composers who endorsed this music, the dance was eventually elevated to a higher level and was established in its proper place in a more, prestigious society throughout the world.


**Day 6: Buenos Aires (B)**

# What to do, what to see?

## Panoramic Buenos Aires City Tour

**Duration:** 3 hours.  
**Frequency:** Daily  
 Discover the beauty and wonders of Buenos Aires: see the 9 de Julio Avenue (the widest avenue in the world), the National Congress, the Metropolitan Cathedral next to the Government House "Casa Rosada" in "Plaza de Mayo" area.  
 Admire the Colon Theatre, one of the most important opera houses in Latin America. And the traditional suburbs: San Telmo, traditional neighborhood where Tango performances can be seen in many bars and restaurants. Stop at La Boca, colorful neighborhood, which was seat of immigrants and now home of artists. Enjoy Palermo, an area that combines its architecture and history with entertainment and amusement in its green spaces. Finally, La Recoleta, an exclusive and elegant neighborhood.

## Buenos Aires: Navigation with Lunch

**Duration:** 3 hours  
**Frequency:** daily except Sunday  
 An excursion with different view of our city by land and water: have lunch during two

hours in a navigation through the Río de la Plata, in a ship full of pleasure and beauty with the best view of Buenos Aires city. Enjoy the excellent cooking aboard in its completely panoramic saloon.

## Tigre – Delta of Paraná River

**Duration:** 5 hours.  
**Frequency:** Daily  
 A pleasant journey along the Río de la Plata coast and through beautiful residential areas. We will leave Buenos Aires City going to the north of the Great Buenos Aires looking for the natural scenery of the Delta and its islands. The way of life the "isleños" (people who lives in the islands) is very special. We will know their costumes, culture and their way of life. We will also see elegant residences located in the residential neighborhoods of the northern suburbs. We will visit San Isidro and the amazing Cathedral and we will pass next to the Presidential Residence (Quinta de Olivos), where all the Argentinean Presidents use to live during their Presidencies. Once we arrive to El Tigre Town, 20 km from the city, we will board a modern panoramic catamaran boat to discover the won-

ders of the Delta of the Parana River and thousands of islands and islets crisscrossed by rivers and brooks.

## Delta Experience

**Duration:** 7 hours  
**Frequency:** upon request  
 A tour to a natural reserve in Tigre Delta area. Departure from Buenos Aires with transfer to Tigre and take a modern boat that allow you to know every corner of Delta, Navigating across streams and shallow channels. Arrival to natural reserve, open to visitors with the purpose of providing them the opportunity to experience the Delta in a special way. Its mission is the conservation of the environment with its associated flora and fauna.

## Evita Tour

**Duration:** 6 hours.  
**Frequency:** Everyday, except Wednesdays and Sundays.  
 A magic tour providing all the answers about this controversial character's life and work. Evita was a taboo, untouchable, and full of mystery for a long time. Places to visit: CGT ( Main Labor Union), Juan Domingo Peron 's House, May

Square's Balcony ( where she gave outstanding speeches), Luna Park ( where she met Peron). Special visit to the Recoleta Cemetery: Evita's Mausoleum and the National Library: it used to be the residence of Eva, the place where she died. Then heading North on to San Isidro residential area to visit Olivos (Presidential Residence).

## Gaucha Party - Show at a Estancia

**Duration:** 9 hours.  
**Frequency:** Daily.  
 Learn the aspects of the Gaucho's life. A whole day in the countryside enjoying horse rides, races, a fabulous barbecue, and "empanadas" (meat pies), all served with argentine wines. Folk music and dancing performances will be shown. It includes a stop at Flea Market on Sundays.

## Tango Show & Dinner

**Duration:** 4 hours.

# What to do, what to see?

## The Big Waters

Magnificent, exotic and adventurous waterfalls, surrounded by exuberant vegetation, semi-precious stone mines, high quality hotels immerse in the nature and several options for an unforgettable stay. Listed as a **UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site** and voted one of the **New 7 Wonders of Nature**, the falls extend over 2,700 meters, with over 260 waterfalls reaching 70 meters high. They can be appreciated from Argentina or Brazil, with the magnificent Devil's Gorge defining the border between the two countries. On the right bank is the Brazilian territory, which has just over 20% of the jumps of these falls, and the left side jumps are Argentine, which make up almost 80% of the falls.

## How to get there

There are two international airports: in the Argentine city of Iguazu, the Argentine Cataratas del Iguazú International Airport and in the Brazilian city, Foz do Iguazú International Airport.



### Argentinian Side Falls

**Duration:** Full day.

The promenade includes 3 important circuits. In the inferior one, the Bozzetti falls, San Martin and The Devil's Throat with an incredible view of falls, which in some cases are 80 meters high. In the superior circuit we will appreciate the panoramic beauty of the landscape. The falls mark the border among Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay. Three Kms. along with exuberant vegetation, a constant way that abruptly get inside the "Garganta del Diablo" (Devil's Throat). This excursion to Argentine side of the falls, gives the opportunity to take the ecological train that crosses the National Park (optional), enjoy a wonderful view of "Garganta del Diablo" (Devil's throat), walk along the paths and get involved with nature.

### Brazilian Side Falls

**Duration:** Half day.

We go along the road that crosses the Iguazu National Park until the beginning of the balconies. At this point, we'll become impressed by the first Cataratas landscape, which allows us to have a panoramic view of the San Martin Island, the Bozzetti falls, and the superior circuit that shows the falls that belong to Argentina. The promenade presents its majestic landscapes. At the end of the path, we can reach the Floriano fall, where we can access to the panoramic elevator to the Devil's Throat and where it can be seen within 150-meter distance.



### Great Adventure

**Duration:** 1.5 hour.

A ride on 4x4 vehicles in the dense sub-tropical jungle. Continue this safari on zodiac type boats, sailing down the river for a breathtaking experience facing the huge impressive falls. It can all be made during the course of the visit to Brazilian side or to Argentinian side of the falls. We will take a ride in 4x4 vehicles, walk along the jungle and navigate down the Iguazu river getting close to the falls.

This tour combine a ride on 4x4 vehicles in the dense sub-tropical jungle and combine latter a safari on zodiac type boats, sailing down the river for a breathtaking experience facing the huge impressive falls. This tour can be done from both sides of the falls, Argentina or Brazil.

# What to do, what to see?



### Itaipú Dam

**Duration:** 2 hours.

40 thousand men and 17 years were needed to construct this dam. The work began in 1974 and in 1991 the last turbine started to operate. The dam has 7.600 meters of length and the lake formed by Itaipu is one of the biggest in the world. Itaipu in Guarani means "The Stone that Sings". The visit: first, a movie is shown to describe what is going to be seen while the plant is being visited. At the end of the movie, there is a 40 minutes promenade, by bus, to visit the most important parts of the spillway, wall of retention and the machinery. We will get to the highest point of Itaipu, going over the walls of retention, where the splendid lake formed by the plant can be observed.

### Wanda Mines

**Duration:** 4 hours.

Wanda was discovered accidentally in 1976, in one of the rivulets where the troops used to stop to rest. Today precious and semiprecious minerals can be extracted. We will know the great basaltic rocks and its crystals. Its formations and varieties will be explained during the visit. Then we will know the extraction process, the work shops and exhibition room, concluding the visit.

### Jesuitical Missions

**Duration:** Full day tour.

The Guarani Indians and the Jesuitic priests formed exemplary communities, based on a peculiar social system, during XVI and XVII centuries, until they were destroyed by the Portuguese colonizers, Spaniards and Brazilians. It's possible to visit the remains of this epopee, which lasted 158 years (1609-1767): The San Ignacio Mission has the necessary infrastructure to receive tourists such as an interpretative museum, illustrative material, spectacle of light and sound and local tour guides.

240 kilometers from Foz do Iguazú we get to the Jesuitic Ruina. The visit starts in a didactical museum, for the interpretation of what will soon be observed: houses, schools, kitchens, square of weapons, cemetery and temple.

### Mocona Waterfalls

**Duration:** full day.

We will depart early in the morning towards the Moconá Falls, through the jungle and the red earth mountains of this region up to the Provincial Park "Moconá".

A spectacular walk in the Moconá Falls and free time to appreciate the indescribable landscapes, taking pictures, etc. It is also possible to taste the regional drink "mate" from Misiones. Later in the afternoon, back to hotel.

### Bird Watching

**Duration:** 2 hours.

Foz Tropicana Bird Park is a private undertaking, located next to the Iguazu Falls, in Brazil. More than 500 tropical, exotic and colored bird species fly over huge aviaries integrated to the exuberant humid subtropical flora. The visitors have the opportunity of getting into the aviaries of more than 630m2 in which cascades and vegetation are recreated, forming a natural habitat frame, where they may know about the life of birds, yacarés, snakes, monkey and butterflies which amaze visitors.

### Aripuca

**Duration:** half day.

In the Aripuca you may appreciate the different agro-eco-tourist activities and share the natural resources in their most pure state. During this visit you may taste homemade organic and regional products, jellies, juices, homemade sweets made from typical fruits of the region, elaborated by regional producers.



# What to do, what to see?



## Salta

Running down Cuesta del Obispo we reach Valley of Lerma dominated by Salta "la linda" (the pretty one). Founded on April, 16th of 1582 by Mr. Hernando de Lerma. The city is at 1.200 mts. above sea level and settled by the 20th of February and San Bernardo Mount. Salta city is probably the town with the largest number of colonial remains in the whole country. Here is where the Train to the Clouds starts its journey up the mountains, which will end in San Antonio de los Cobres, 4.200 meters above sea level and 163 Km away from Salta.

beautiful villages is Purmamarca, an indigenous village lying against the Cerro de los Siete Colores (Seven-color Mount). Further on, there is an area of mountains with bright-coloured stripes, known as La Paleta del Pintor (The Artist's Palette), in Maimará. One of the most outstanding attractions in this ravine is the Pucará de Tilcara, a fortified town built by the Omaguaca natives in pre-Columbian times. Humahuaca was founded by the Spanish by the end of the XVI century. Quebrada de Humahuaca was declared World Cultural Landscape by the UNESCO in July 2nd 2003.

## Tucumán


Capital of the smallest Argentine province and known as "the Garden of the Republic" because of the richness of its flora, San Miguel de Tucumán preserves intact traces of its colonial history. After crossing green sugar cane fields, the road leads into the Quebrada de los Sosas and we reach Tafí del Valle at the foot of the impressive Sierra del Aconquija.

## Purmamarca

Purmamarca is a little village of the incredible colored mountains, on the route to "Quebrada (Canyon) de Humahuaca". In this village there are some small hotels "de charme" and it is very recommended to stay one or more nights over to live the magic of the North of Argentina.

## Jujuy

Departing from San Salvador de Jujuy, we reach this natural road leading to the Altiplano (high plateau). Vividly colored landscapes frame a group of villages with adobe houses, historical chapels and Pre-Hispanic ruins, where time seems to stand still. One of the most



## Quebrada de Humahuaca

**Duration:** 14 hrs  
**Distance:** 520 kms  
 We'll leave Salta to go to San Salvador de Jujuy, where we will briefly visit the city. Then we will continue on to Purmamarca: Here we will be able to be delight with one of the greatest beauties of the Northwest: Cerro de los Siete Colores ("Hill of the Seven Colors"). First we will pass through Posta de Hornillos and Maimará, in the center of the canyon. We'll see the multicolored hills that complete the "Paleta del Pintor" (Painter's Palette). We'll turn north, to go to Tilcara where we will visit Pucará. Pucará is the reconstruction of the town of the pre-Hispanic Omaguacas, a culture that lived 900 years ago. Before reaching Humahuaca, we'll take a quick look at Huacalera and Uquía. Return to Salta.

## Cafayate

**Duration:** 12hrs  
**Distance:** 390 kms  
 In Cafayate, San Carlos, Angastaco, Molinos and Cachi, Spanish traditions and customs are still kept. Specially in relation to art, architecture, as well as religious imagery. Leaving Cafayate, surrounded by vineyards where the famous Torrontés white wine is produced, the highway leads to Quebrada de las Conchas. Not only the Valles Calchaquíes, but also Los Cardones National Park may be visited. The term "cardón" means giant cactus, and natives skillfully used this plant to build

their houses. Departure from Salta city to travel through Lerma Valley, an important tobacco's manufacturer area. We will enter Quebrada del río las Conchas (declared Natural Monument's by UNESCO) due to the colorful mountains and its formation. We will go through a mountain road from where we can appreciate different shapes like: The Amphitheater, Devil's Throat, The Monk, The Castles. Arrival at Cafayate, located in the Calchaquies Valleys, winery area. Visiting a winery. Return to Salta.

## Train to the Clouds

**Duration:** 16 hours.  
**Period:** From April to November.  
 The trip goes straight to heaven, embracing along the way small Andean villages and ruins of thousand years old civilizations that have mysteriously disappeared. We'll take the Train to the Clouds to go to the viaduct La Polvorilla, ascending up to 4,220 metres above the sea level. This railroad of incredible engineering was created in 1941 to be used by heavy trains to carry minerals. It travels 220 km crossing valleys, canyons and the Puna and goes through places like the Quebrada del Toro, the zigzag of Alisal station and the La Polvorilla viaduct. At the Alisal station, the train changes to a parallel track and the locomotive goes to the back of the train to lead it inside a tunnel. Once it crosses the tunnel the locomotive goes back to normal position.

The entire landscape is composed in a harmony of colors that nature put in the peaks, hills, plateaus and snow-capped mountains of the impressive PUNA, adding to the magnificent engineering feat that are the train tracks unique for its bridges, tunnels, Zig-zags and viaducts.

## Cachi

**Duration:** 12 hrs.  
**Distance:** 320 kms.  
 Departure from Salta city to travel through Lerma Valley, an important tobacco's manufacturer area. We will enter the impressive Cuesta del Obispo, an old aboriginal road 3.348 mts. above sea level. Then we will go through Los Cardones National Park, Recta del Tin Tin arriving Cachi, colonial town.





### Sapagua gorge and Hornaditas Community

**Duration: 08 hrs**  
**Distance: 120 kms**  
 We depart from Tilcara or Purmamarca to Hornaditas and the Gorge of Sapagua. There is a place called El Pintado, full of petroglyphs where we will stop and have free time for photos and a soft hike. We will continue to the small community of Hornaditas, to visit the oldest Cardon of the region and the main church of this town. Time for lunch in a rural house, where the owners will welcome us with a typical dish, the visit continues with an explanation of their rural activities and a complete visit of the surrounding accompanied by one of their host. After this rich experience in a Coya family, we return to the hotel.

### Colorful towns and gorges

**Duration: 10 hrs.**  
**Distance: 250 kms.**  
 We depart from Tilcara to cross "Peña Blanca", east border of the Quebrada of Humahuaca. After a few kilometers we visit the first towns. The overwhelming plains of the Coctaca Valley remind one of the main Inca agricultural sites. Walk around this valley and stop for lunch (box lunch). In the afternoon we continue hiking for 2,5 hours until arriving to Cerro Negro to watch the ancient paintings on rocks. A belvedere can be appreciated with a spectacular view over the valley. After getting back in our vehicle we cross by different towns such as Valiaso and Pucará to climb the Serrania of Santa Barbara (Santa Barbara Hills) reaching 4200 mts. above sea level. We will finish at the viewpoint at Cerro Horconal, with beautiful views over the Abra (huge prairie) de Zenta. Return to Tilcara.

### Llama Trekking

**Duration: 4 hrs.**  
**Distance: 10 kms.**  
 We do treks and hikes with llamas in La Quebrada de Humahuaca, Jujuy, with base in Tilcara, in programs of 90 minutes. This tour starts in Tilcara, ideal for families with children or for people who just want to enjoy a relaxing walk with Llamas, there are also shorter walks of 90 minutes. Llamas cannot be ridden; but they carry the luggage needed for the trek. All trips include quality camping gear; delicious and plentiful food, good wine and, of course, the "Llamas". We will walk through a flat path towards the North, along the Rio Grande (Grand River), surrounded by the spectacular landscape of La Quebrada de Humahuaca. After 45 minutes of trekking we arrive to "La Laguna de los Patos" (The Duck's lagoon). We download the llamas and we will have a nice lunch. We return to Tilcara through an alternative path.






# Mendoza Vineyards & Mountains

## The Land of the Good Sun and the Good Wine

**Mendoza** is the Capital City of the homonymous province and the most important city of the west of Argentina. It is situated at the foot of **The Andes** and is an incredible oasis to grow fruits and vegetables due to the presence of Mendoza and Tunuyan Rivers. It is one of the most chosen tourist destinations because of the various interesting activities available in the region. Starting point to enjoy adventure tourism, high mountain sports, visit ancient cellars and taste **excellent wines**: the land become one of the principal wine world producers, with products of outstanding quality.

The region displays the full splendour of the central Andean range, **The Aconcagua** (6,959 m.) is the highest peak in the Western hemisphere, and its steep slopes are renowned and respected by mountain climbers from all over the world.

The climate of the region is mild though the mountains provide certain degree of aridity. When you are visiting Mendoza, you are in "the land of the good sun and the good wine".

**Las Leñas**, is one the most important **ski center** in Latin America, during winter in south hemisphere ski and snowboard can be practiced among other activities offered.

Located: 418 km far from Mendoza City.



### Mendoza City tour

**Duration:** half day.

Land with historic tradition, it keeps many memories of San Martin's epic in the Cerro de la Gloria (Hill of the Glory), historical founding area, main streets and squares, civic centre, General San Martin Park and the museums that show documents testifying the presence in the region of the Argentinean eminent person. Starting point to enjoy **adventure tourism** and High Mountain sports like mountain ascension, climbing, horse riding and rafting.

### Wine route

**Duration:** half day or full day.

The very well-known "**Ruta de los Vinos**" (Wine route) deserves a special mention because tourists can visit ancient cellars and taste excellent wines which are product of carefully chosen grapes. The land becomes one of the principal

wine world producers, with products of outstanding quality. The Province of Mendoza is divided into three wine growing regions:

**The north and the east include** the departments of Maipú, Luján de Cuyo, Junín, San Martín, Rivadavia, Lavalle, Guaymallén, Godoy Cruz and Las Heras. Principal Wineries: Tapiz, Lagarde, Chandon, Catena Zapata, Bodegas Lopez, Zuccardi, among others.

**The Uco valley region** includes the departments of Tunuyán, Tupungato and San Carlos. Principal Wineries in this region: Andeluna, Bodegas Salentein, Clos de los 7, O. Fournier, among others.

**The south** includes San Rafael and General Alvear departments. Principal Wineries in this region: Algodon Wine States, Sutter, Casa Bianchi, Lavaque, among others.

On this tour, wineries and olive oil factory are visited; take a walk among vineyards and learn how these tempting elixirs are made. Having

lunch at "Casa del Visitante" of Zuccardi family or enjoy different wine tasting at the wineries from the different grapes such as: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Bonarda, Pinot noir, Syrah, Semillon, Chardonnay, Chenin blanc.

### High Andes – Aconcagua

**Duration:** full day

From Mendoza city, along de Mendoza River up to the border with Chile, 100 km from the city you can find the Uspallata Valley, setting of the native Huarpes during pre-hispanic times. Historical bridge over the Picheuta river; **Puerta del Inca** (2720 m).

Next to there are thermal springs.. Natural viewpoint allows you to appreciate the magnificent **Aconcagua Mountain** (6,959 m.) is the highest peak in America!

**Las Cuevas** (3200 m.) a small village from where you reach to the Monument of Cristo Redentor (4200m) along a panoramic road, until the border of Chile.


## The Land of Dinosaurs

In the valleys of La Rioja and San Juan, among leaves of grapevines, farms, wineries we find the unbelievable **Ischigualasto and Talampaya**, which share a geological basin of approximately 5,000 sq. Km and were inscribed on the UNESCO's World Heritage List. Ischigualasto also known as **Moon valley**, is located in San Juan province while **Talampaya** is located in La Rioja province.

Venture in this land is a trip into the past!

This region offers wonderful visit to **archaeological reserves and paleontological treasures**, ancient villages erected in beautiful landscapes and wineries where the history of viticulture experience.

Famous **wineries** are: Merced del Alto, winner of best "Malbec Argentino" wine in 2012 and Graffigna, one of the biggest winery in Argentina, that offer the visit to the Museum and wine tasting.



# What to do, what to see?

### Ischigualasto – Moon Valley

Ischigualasto Provincial Park, in the Province of San Juan, 330 km from San Juan city, is one of the most important paleontologic sites in the world. It covers a 25 Km long by 10 Km wide area. Fossil remains of vertebrates that inhabited the place in the Mesozoic and Jurassic era, from 180 million years ago, as well as dinosaur footprints, fern leaf prints, and petrified araucarias trunks can be found in this amazing park. The landscape displays an extraordinary diversity of shapes and colors. Excursion is developed following a circuit within the park. The famous shapes are: El Submarino, Cancha de Bochas, El Gusano, Cerro Morado, El hongo among others. We do recommend to stay at Villa Union 135 km from Ischigualasto.

### Talampaya

Talampaya National Park is located in the Province of La Rioja and has an area of 215,000 Ha. Its major attraction are its brick-red rock steep cliffs with thousands of distinctive shapes carved by erosion, where condors nest. The most popular area is a 3-Km-wide Canyon with all kinds of sandstone formations and 150-meter-tall walls. This place is rich in precious archaeological remains such as stone mortars and pre-Columbian petro glyphs. The service within the park includes two different Canyon tours. The options differ in the point they reach after visiting Talampaya Canyon, in one case, the tour reaches the site known as El Monje, while in the other, the final destination is Los Cajones. Another alternative for adventurous is the 4x4 Adventure Safari, in this case the toured performed aboard a 4x4 truck. We do recommend to stay at Villa Union, 55 km from Talampaya.



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# What to do, what to see?

## Andean Patagonia: Bariloche

### Lakes, Mountains & Woods

“The Best Place in the World is Llaolao Peninsula” (National Geographic)  
 Its inside the Nahuel Huapi National Park, where a glacial lake covers 560 square kilometres and its creeks reach into the millenary forests. On its shore is San Carlos de Bariloche City, a first-class tourist center, where the well-known Cerro Catedral winter resort is situated, and which offers an active cultural life and is an ideal place for adventure and outdoor activities.  
 Catedral, is one the most important ski center in Latin America, during winter in south hemisphere ski and snowboard can be practiced among other activities offered.  
**Distance:** 16 km from Bariloche.

#### Small Circuit

**Duration: half day**  
 The tour starts in Bariloche, riding down Ezequiel Bustillo Ave.: a winding paved road along the Nahuel Huapi lakeshore. At kilometer 8, we come to Playa Bonita, from where we can see Huemul Island. Continuing along this road for another 10 km, and after passing through some beautiful scenery, we arrive at Campanario Hill. A chair lift takes to the top of the hill (1050 m) from where we can enjoy one of the most impressive views of this region. We will see Nahuel Huapi and Moreno lakes, El Trébol lagoon, San Pedro and Llaolao peninsulas, Victoria Island, Otto, López, Goye and Catedral hills, and the main town, San Carlos de Bariloche. Further ahead, and after leaving San Pedro peninsula behind, we reach Llaolao peninsula, with its namesake hilltop hotel and San Eduardo Chapel, two architectural jewels of this region.

#### Big Circuit

**Duration: full day**  
 We start the excursion along National Route 237, cross the outlet of Nahuel Huapi Lake

and the spring of Limay river, geographical limit between the provinces of Río Negro and Neuquén. Following Limay river, passing by the Amphitheater and then going on towards the Valle Encantado (enchanted valley) and Confluencia Traful, a region of transition between the Patagonian steppe and the Patagonian Andean forest. Leaving behind Route 237, we take Provincial Route 65 west, towards Villa Traful bordering Traful river until we reach a natural balcony overlooking Traful Lake. The road continues bordering the lake, passes through Villa Traful and head towards Arrayanes Port. From there we go on up, through a shady forest, to El Portezuelo (940 m a.s.l.) where we meet the Seven Lakes Road going southwards and bordering lakes Correntoso, Bailey Willis, and Espejo. Finally we go along National Route 231 towards Villa La Angostura.

**Duration: full day**  
 This excursion may begin in Bariloche or Pañuelo Port, on the Llaolao Peninsula. After sailing 30 minutes, you arrive at Anchorena Port on Victoria Island. From there you can wander through various trails. On board again, the ship sails northwest towards Quetrihué Port where you will see the world famous Bosque de Arrayanes (myrtle wood), which is absolutely unique and harbors centenary trees. This wood has been declared intangible area and natural monument. The excursion ends upon return to Pañuelo Port or Bariloche.

**Duration: half day**  
 Its name originated in the similarity of its summit with the towers of gothic cathedrals. Cathedral Hill is a first-class ski and winter sports resort. From the base there are various ski lifts that take the visitor to the different ski runs.

#### Road Of The Seven Lakes

**Duration: full day**  
 This excursion leaves Bariloche northwards along National Route 237, for 21 km until you meet secondary route F. This is a winding road, with natural beauty all around. You go past Manzano Port and arrive in Villa La Angostura. Once you left the village behind, you will be on the Camino de los Siete Lagos, or Seven Lakes Road: these are Correntoso, Espejo, Villarino, Falkner, Hermoso, Machónico, and Meliquina. Finally, you arrive to San Martín de los Andes on the shores of Lácar Lake. The return trip to Bariloche can be through Paso Córdoba or along National Route 40 via Junín de los Andes and La Rinconada.

**Duration: full day**  
 We leave Bariloche southwards and border Gutierrez and Mascardi lakes. Further on, the road also borders the western arm of Mascardi Lake along a winding road up to Pampa Linda. After riding a few more kilometers we get to a brook where we will stop for a 30 minutes' walk: after crossing a suspension bridge we will go through a forest of lenga (Nothofagus pumilio) and canes (Chusquea culeou) until we reach a cliff from where you can enjoy the view of Las Nalcas fall. All around the fall we can see the great nalca (Chilean rhubarb) leaves that can grow as big as a meter wide. We go back on time for lunch and continue later to the Black Glacier belvedere. Return is scheduled at 15:45 so as to be back at the hotel at 18:00. From September to November there is a lot of water. From December to April, the water fall becomes much thinner. And from May to October, the excursion depends on the road condition. Lunch and National Park fee are not included.

### Lake Crossing - Sail the Andes

**“Enjoy the nature at the very End of the World”**  
 All the South of Argentina and Chile. The CRUCE DE LAGOS (LAKE CROSSING) is a crossing trip either from Puerto Montt (Chile) or from Bariloche (Argentina), any time of the year. Combines bus and boat trips along several towns and lakes, surrounded by The Andes and ancient forests. You shall sail through Nahuel Huapi, Frías and Todos Los Santos Lakes and be astonished by the color of the waters. A concentration of beautiful sights rarely found in other parts of the world.

Staying at Peulla or Puerto Blest, all the towns have good hotels, restaurants, shops and transportation services that make its attractions accessible to people of all ages and preferences. Let the nature of the zone to delight you. Attractive excursions at your wishes. Fishing in excellent rivers, skiing down the slopes of volcanoes, rafting down whitewater rivers, bird-watching in the forests or climbing up to the craters of the volcanoes themselves.




### Andean Crossing - Beyond borders...

We begin our trip from Puerto Montt until Frutillar; at the shore of the Llanquihue Lake and with the magnificent view of Osorno Volcano. Only 26 km from Frutillar we'll visit a dream city called Puerto Octay. We will arrive to the “Volcanoes Viewpoint”. Over the next 80 km, we will pass through the Rupanco property where the agricultural and cattle activities offer us a vision of the richness and fertility of these lands. Bordering Puyehue lake shore, surrounded by Temperate Rain Forest, lakes, volcanoes, valleys, rivers and waterfalls will be allowed to us accede to the Cardenal Samore border (**limit between Chile and Argentina**), where we'll proceed with the migratory steps. This path integrates the **Puyehue National Park in Chile and Nahuel Huapi National Park** in Ar-

gentina and takes us to the highest point of the Andes Mountains range to 1321 mts. above sea level. At noon, we'll arrive at Villa La Angostura, located to the northwest of the lake Nahuel Huapi. We'll visit this charming city. We will have time to enjoy the lunch in a comfortable familiar atmosphere. (From the middle of March to the middle of October, the Andean Crossing is doable in 2 days/1 night, staying over in Villa la Angostura). After lunch, we'll navigate through Nahuel Huapi Lake towards the Arrayanes National Park, where native trees are about 300 years old. This place was declared as an Intangible Area and Natural Heritage Site. Finally we will arrive to Pañuelo Port, at the beautiful Peninsula Llaolao and follow the tour by bus for 25 km until arriving to the city of Bariloche.





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# Atlantic Patagonia: Valdés area

## Whales, Penguins & Sea Lions

This is the largest peninsula of the Atlantic Coast. It is famous for its concentration of marine fun. It is an island linked to the continent by a narrow strip of land called Carlos Ameghino Isthmus, separating San José and Nuevo Gulfs.

**Península Valdés** is located in the Province of Chubut, in the middle of the Patagonia region. In front of this Peninsula, hundreds of **Southern Whales** come every year from June to December to mate, give birth and breed the young in calm waters. Afterwards, they continue their mysterious way along the Ocean.



## MEF – Paleontology Museum Egidio Feruglio.

The MEF of Trelew is a Center of Scientific Activities related to paleontology and natural sciences. On this Museum we highlight the surprising presence of Dinosaurs and we may go along a time line into the past, just from the first Patagonian inhabitants to the beginning of life on Earth.



# What to do? What to see?

## Península Valdés

**Duration:** 11 hrs

**Kms:** 400 kms

Departure heading North taking the Interstate route N. 1. After going through 77 kms we arrive to Istmo Carlos Ameghino, narrow band of land from where Golfo San José and Golfo Nuevo can be seen. Going towards Península Valdés rich in flora and fauna, we arrive to **Puerto Pirámides**, from where from June to first days of December it's possible to embark and start the **whales watching** (2 hrs sailing approx.). From Puerto Piramides we can also see the **marine wolves** during the breeding time, that is to say from December to March.

We continue our way to **Punta Delgada**, in the southeast point of the peninsula, a beautiful landscape surrounded by high cliffs and a marvelous panoramic view.

Going on to **Caleta Valdés**, we will see along the coast the **marine elephants** that weight between 1 and 3 tons. Then we start our return.

## Estancia San Lorenzo (Penguins' Natural Reserve)

**Period:** From September to April.

A unique farm with its own personal "pingüinera" Reserve, with more than 200 thousand Magellanic Penguins, located in the Península Valdés. We will visit the incredible land of penguins next to the beach over the Atlantic Ocean. In this typical Patagonian farm it is possible to have lunch as well, Lamb and variety of meat.

This visit can be combined the same day with Península Valdés excursion.

## Whales Watching

**Duration:** 1 hrs.

**Period:** From June to early December

Sailing from Puerto Piramides on an embarkation to observe the whales and being observed by them, in their natural environment. It will be able to appreciate them and the panoramic sights from the outdoor. Naturalistic guides and the captain will help you to understand their behavior and characteristics. Responsible and respectful practice is applied.

## Whales Watching with Yellow Submarine

NEW

**Duration:** 1.5 hrs.

**Period:** From June to early December.

This new and unique embarkation allows you to watch whales submersed in their habitat, combined with the panoramic sights from the outdoor upper deck. Underwater the perspective looks completely different, which is comparable only to the experience of diving among them. While whales remain close to the vessel, we can watch them all the time through the 40 viewing windows on the submersed lower deck. Responsible and respectful practice is applied.



## Punta Tombo

**Duration:** 8 hrs.

**Distance:** 350 kms.

**Period:** From September to April.

We will take the national route N° 3 towards South until reaching the crossroads with the interstate route N.1 that will lead us to Punta Tombo, located by the Atlantic Ocean (107 km far from Trelew). It is a stony and narrow band that sinks in the sea and where every year an estimated of 1 to 2 millions of Magellanic penguins arrive and stay from September to April, breeding their nest eggs and changing their feathers.

Together with Glaciers Onelli, Upsala, Agassiz and Spegazzini compose the Argentino Lake Area, within Los Glaciares National Park. The Park was created in 1937 and it covers 600.000 hectares and shelters 356 glaciers. It was declared World Heritage by the UNESCO, in 1981.




This town, located on the shore of Argentino Lake, is the door to enter to the world of the glaciers. It takes its name from a small bush that grown in the Patagonia. It's the head of Los Glaciares National Park and was founded in 1927.

El Chalten is located in the Argentino Lake area, in the confluence of River Vueltas and River Fitz Roy in the area of Los Glaciares National Park.

In this spot the magic of the glaciers combine with hidden lagoons, farms, Lake Viedma and the magnetic presence of Mount Fitz Roy. It is 220 km away from El Calafate and 200 people live there. It's located next to Lake Viedma and is an appropriate place for trekking, and that's why it has been declared Capital City for trekking. Torre Hill, Fitz Roy Mount and Glaciers Viedma, Upsala and Moyano are a must to see.

# What to do? What to see?

## Perito Moreno Glacier

**Duration: 7 hours**  
**Kms: 160 kms**  
 Departure early in the morning to Los Glaciares National Park. After sorting a winding road and after bordering the Argentino Lake, we'll reach the paths and balconies of the Perito Moreno Glacier.  
 Free time to enjoy this magnificent giant Glacier. The Glacier's balconies are located 80 km. from El Calafate village. Perito Moreno Glacier has a front of 4 km. Its height is of approximately 30-60 mts with a surface of 195 Sq. Km. and a length of 30 km.



## Minitrekking on the Perito Moreno Glacier

**Duration: Full day**  
 We cover 70 km. to Bajo de las Sombras Port, where we embark for 20 minutes navigation to cross Rico Bend of Argentino Lake, enjoying breathtaking views of the glacier's front walls and Icebergs Channel. When we arrive to the opposite shore, specialized mountain guides welcome and take us to a small shelter. There we put on crampons to start the trekking on the ice of the Perito Moreno Glacier.  
 The two hours circuit that follows introduces the fascinating landscape of the glaciers: streams, small lagoons, gullies, crevasses and plenty of ice formations of the most incredible blues. The trekking is moderate. The ice surface over which we walk is irregular, but firm and safe.

## Nautical Safari

**Duration: 1 hour**  
 This excursion takes you on a boat ride across the Rico lake, passing among icebergs which have calved off the front of the Perito Moreno Glacier. Reaching the Icebergs Channel, the boat will stop at a safe distance from the glacier, continuing to sail down all its front, allowing a spectacular view of the high wall of ice. The embarkment takes place at the "Bajo de las Sombras" bay, about 6 km before the glacier Balconies.


## Todo Glaciares Sailing

**Duration: Full day**  
 Departure from the hotel to Puerto Bandera to board modern boats that will take us towards **Upsala Glacier** (108 km approx. 10 hours 30'), navigating along the waters of Argentino Lake. While sailing the **Spegazzini channel**, we'll be able to observe the homonymous glacier. After crossing "Garganta del Diablo" (Devil's Throat), we'll stop in front of the biggest glacier of "Los Glaciares National Park", the "Upsala Glacier" (a length of 60 kms, surface 595 Sq. Km. width 7 kms and height 80 mts) to appreciate its magnificence. On our way back, we continue sailing until Onelli Bay, where we'll disembark (if it's allowed by the weather conditions). On our way back we will see the **Spegazzini Glacier**, the highest glacier of the park (135 mts).



## Estancia Cristina

**Duration: 10 hours**  
 Departure early in the morning from hotel to Puerto Banderas to board a modern and comfortable boat. Navigation across Argentino Lake among icebergs overlooking the western front of Upsala glacier, towards the location of Estancia Cristina. Rest of the day enjoying the Estancia, guided visits to its surroundings, walks and 4wd ride. Return and board to start our way back to El Calafate.



# What to do, what to see?

## Glaciarium – The Ice Museum

**Duration: 3 hours**  
 Open in 2011 it is a modern glacier Interpretation Centre, built to entertain and educate about ice, glaciers and the Patagonian Ice Fields. Inside there is the one and only in South America, GlacioBar, entirely designed in ice, with open bar for the 20 minutes is allowed to stay. Proper cloth and globes are given. Different entrance tickets for GlacioBar and the Museum.



## El Chalten

**Duration: 8 hrs.**  
**Distance: 220 kms.**  
 Departure early in the morning from Calafate with bus for 220 km, enjoying the view of the mythical Route 40. Once we arrive to El Chalten town, visit to the Interpretation Center and afterwards you may choose between doing free trekking on your own or guided trekking and navigation with our guides. In the late afternoon, after a yummy hot chocolate, we will head back to El Calafate with bus.





## What to do? What to see?

### Balcones

**Duration:** 3/4 hrs.

**Distance:** 45 kms.

We leave from El Calafate. We go upwards at about 1050 m over sea level until we arrive at the first balcony where passengers can enjoy a panoramic view of El Calafate and the eastern part of Argentino Lake (if it is not cloudy, we can also see Chaltén and Torre Hills and the condor's flight). Then we start descending up to a place for a snack. We return to El Calafate by descending and having a look at the breathtaking Argentino Lake all the time.



### El Galpon (Patagonean Farm & Hotel)


**Duration:** 4 hrs.

It is an old Sheep Farm located 22 km from El Calafate (15 minutes away) on the route towards the National Park. From October to April it welcomes you in its warm and cozy 16 comfortable rooms surrounded by 3,5 kilometers of shores of the Argentino Lake and by 1,5 kilometer of riverbank of the Centinela River. There are also guided visits to the shearing shed, flock gathering demos by Kelpie dogs, walks to "De las Aves" Lagoon, combined with a tea and homemade sweets and cakes, and finally a delicious Patagonian lamb barbecues dinner.


### Nibepo Aike (Patagonean Farm)

**Duration:** 6 hours

The farm is located within Los Glaciares National Park, 56 km from El Calafate. Nibepo Aike is a typical pioneer farm of the early XX century; its chief production is beef cattle, with sheep as a secondary line. Guided visits are possible combined with lunch or dinner, based on the Patagonian typical barbecued lamb. After dessert and free time to relax, there will be another hike to the Southern Bend. During this path we will discover a ñire and lenga forest where caracaras, cachafías (small parrots), hares, woodpeckers, eagles and a wide variety of native flora and fauna live. Around 15.00 we will start our way back to El Calafate.

At 16:00, the cruise will reach the Bahía Tranquila Harbor (Punta Bandera), which is the end of the journey. # Chilean Patagonia



## Paine Tower National Park

Almost at the end of the Patagonia in the extreme south of Chile you will find Torres del Paine, a place of great natural attractions, among them the surprising "Cuernos del Paine" (Horns of Paine) which have given the region international recognition.

Torres del Paine National Park, declared a **Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO** in 1978, rich in animals and Patagonian species, is internationally known as one of the most beautiful, pure, and unique places on the planet. Its main attractions rest in the spectacular landscape itself, Torres and Cuernos del Paine, the lakes (Sarmiento, Nordenskjold, Pehoe, Grey, Paine, and Dickson), the flora and fauna that make this an ideal place for ecotourism and adventure sports.

**Milodon Cave National Monument**, in the vicinity of the park, located 24 Kms. north of **Puerto Natales**. This natural monument is composed of three caves and a rock formation known as Silla del Diablo (Devil's Seat). In 1896 the scientific world was fascinated by the discovery in this cave of the skin, bones and other parts of an extinct animal, the Milodon (Myloodon Darwini). The main cave is 150 meters above sea level, and it measures 30 meters high, 80 meters long and 200 meters deep.

In this area, the **Balmaceda and Serrano glaciers** are found in the fjord Ultima Esperanza (Last Hope), accessible by sea.



## The Train of the End of the World

**The train at the End of the World or Southern Fuegean Railway**, is the first ecological train of the world since it reaches and enters a part of National Park of Tierra del Fuego (Fireland) that had been hidden for a long time. The train is made up of steam locomotives and comfortable wagons. It is situated 10km to the West, outside the city of Ushuaia. Originally, the train was used by the prisoners to cut wood and take it from the actual territory of National Park to the city. It follows Pipo River and takes 1 hour and 40 minutes to reach its destination point. It crosses different sites where the prisoners used to work every day 100 years ago. An area of sub-

Antarctic forest, one of the last such forests in the world... During the journey passengers will be accompanied by a bilingual guide (Spanish-English), who will recount the history of the "Convict Train". **Passengers can enjoy:**

- **The landscape:** rivers, waterfalls, forests, mountains, peat bogs, all of which are typical features of Tierra del Fuego.
- **The history** of the convict train and its relationship with the city of Ushuaia. Travelling on a historic railway, complete with steam locomotives, the magic and enchantment of a past era.

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# Ushuaia, the End of the World

**Tierra del Fuego and the World's southernmost city, Ushuaia, between Pacific and Atlantic Oceans, are the gateway towards the vast and mysterious Antarctica. Different Cruises to Antarctica and Cape Horn depart from here.**

*Visiting the old prison, today the Maritime Museum, or at the End of the World Museum, you will travel back in time... Along the Beagle channel you will see seals, Magellanic penguins and cormorants. A small train can take you to the gates of Tierra del Fuego National Park, inhabited by diverse flora and fauna species, such as red foxes, guanacos, beavers and condors.*

## Ushuaia City tour & Museum

**Duration: 2,5 hours.**  
**Distance: 25 km.**

Ushuaia, an over 100 years old city, offers a wide interesting history to be shared, full of secrets, legends and adventures. The visit implies a route around several places such as the Old Town Centre, the port and the steep streets that climb the mountain. In this way it is possible to get a lot of varied colorful panoramic views. We finish the excursion by visiting the End of the World Museum, which is located at one of the oldest buildings in the city. Our suggestion after the tour is to visit the Presidium Museum, the Old Prison, which now houses different sections, including the maritime museum.



## Tierra del Fuego National Park

**Duration: 4 hours.**  
**Distance: 50 km.**

Only 12 km. west from Ushuaia is the entrance to Tierra del Fuego National Park. Lengas, Calafates and Notros are the species of trees that you will find here. It was created in 1960. It is the southernmost park in Argentina. In a half-day tour we will meet its fantastic panoramic views of lakes, mountains, woods and rivers that can be appreciated while driving along National Route 3 until we get to Lapataia Bay. Interactive walks are made during the visit.

## Sailing the Beagle Channel

**Duration: 2,5 hours.**  
**Distance: 30 km.**

Sea Lions' Island  
This is a catamaran sailing Beagle Channel in which we will see Sea Lions' and Birds' Islands as well as Les Eclaireurs Lighthouse; all of them embellished by the typical nature in the area. We will sail in new, comfortable ships from

where we will appreciate colonies of diverse sea birds nesting in islands and cliffs such as cormorants, albatros, petrels, oyster birds, etc, as well as colonies of sea lions. During this amazing sailing we will also have one of the best views of the southernmost city in the world and the mountains that surround it as well.

## Escondido & Fagnano Lakes

**Duration: 7 hours.**  
**Distance: 130 km.**

This excursion takes us to travel around a wide variety of landscapes. After leaving Ushuaia eastwards, we stop to watch the whole Old Prison; we go past the industrial area and once we go deep into the forest, Velo de la Novia Waterfall will surprise us. On bordering Olivia Mount base, the imposing Alvear Hill can be seen at the front with its eternal snow and a huge peat bog valley at its base. When the road goes past Rancho Hambre, the ascent starts. At 430 meters over sea level, we can enjoy an unforgettable view of Escondido and Fagnano Lakes. We descend towards Escondido Lake shore where Petrel Inn is located. When we leave the inn, we take national route 3 again to start our travel by the sawmill area where lengas (*Nothofagus pumilio*) make a dense even forest. A few kilometers ahead a detour leads us to the biggest lake in Tierra del Fuego. Fagnano Lake is so big that some birds lose their way and wind makes them fly over it. That is why we can see some albatrosses and petrels. Our return is by the same national route 3 straight ahead to Ushuaia.



# What to do? What to see?

## Harberton & Escondido Lake

**Duration: 9 hours.**

Departures from Ushuaia by bus and return by ship and / or departures by ship and return by bus. The means of transport for departing (land or sea) is told to passengers at the destination due to operative reasons. Both options are exactly the same as regards of service, places and visit time during the excursion. In Escondido Lake we make some stops (Carbajal Valley / Tierra Mayor Valley, Las Cotorras Valley, Castor Hill, Garibaldi Pass). We visit Petrel Inn and then we go to Harberton Farm past Rancho Hambre and we stop at Victoria Lagoon. Free time for lunch. After lunching, a guided visit to the farm and, as optional, visit to the museum. We embark in a catamaran to return by sea and visit the Penguins' Island, the light house, Birds' Island and Sea Lions' Island.

## Trekking & Canoeing at National Park

**Duration: 8/10 hours.**

We depart from the hotel by minibus to the National Park, specifically Ensenada Bay where

we can enjoy some wonderful views of Beagle Channel and start our trek by the coastline. A route of 7 km allows us to meet the channel-varied flora and avifauna as well as some remains of the old yamanas' settlements. After a 3-hour trek we arrive in Roca Lake for a hot lunch and canoeing in Lapataia River that leads us to our goal: Lapataia Bay in Beagle Channel at the right point where the Route finishes. We return to Ushuaia by minibus. It includes: Transfers by minibus and snack, hot lunch and naturalist guide.

## Off-road Lakes and mountain bike tours

**Duration: 6/8 hours.**

There are different off roads tours: in 4 wheel drive or with mountain bikes, combined with canoeing or not, accompanied by professional 4w drivers and naturalistic guides. It is a different and intense way of knowing the surroundings with its secrets hidden and having fun. This adventure is accessible to anyone. An off-road bicycle, some basic equipment (a rucksack, a rainy suit, a helmet and gloves) and a packed lunch are provided.

## Fishing in the end of the World

**Duration: 8/10 hours.**

Tailor made fishing program with experienced guide. In this province there are trouts widely spread in its rivers, lagoons and lakes like Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout and Steelhead Trout. The fishing day starts early in the morning and the return is foreseen in the evening.

## Skiing

Ushuaia is the national capital of cross-country skiing. This city features a great variety of trails, developed along natural terrain. Marchablanca, for instance, is one of the traditional competitions related to this discipline which passes through different hot spots of Valle de Tierra Valley. This competition generally takes place in August, and enthusiasts of all ages take part in it. Even if you have never practiced cross-country skiing, don't hesitate to do it if you're visiting Ushuaia.





40 until arriving the village of Perito Moreno. Lodge at Los Antiguos, little village in the border with Chile. Dinner and Overnight (Tot. 520 kms.)



We will take an enchanted walk through the Magellan Forest of lengas, coigües, canelos, ferns, and other endemic vegetation, to reach a panoramic viewpoint.

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## Punta del Este The Place and the Beaches

At the beginning of the 19th century, Punta del Este was a vast semi-deserted region only visited by sailors and fishermen. Today this coastal town, commonly referred to as the **St. Tropez of South America**, attracts close to 300,000 visitors each year.

At the East of Montevideo (Uruguay's capital city), **Punta del Este is at 355Kms. away from Buenos Aires - Argentina, and 1.745Kms. from San Pablo - Brasil.**

This excellent tourist venue is **45 minutes flight from Buenos Aires** and has an International Airport, another for shuttles and private airplanes and an exclusive Yacht Port located in the center of the peninsula. Opposite the large peninsula separating the waters of the Atlantic Ocean and Rio de la Plata, lie the enchanted islands of Isla Gorriti and Isla de los Lobos, inhabited by one of the world's largest sea-lion colonies.

**Punta del Este City.** Place where the Atlantic Ocean is born, it has been developed an urbanization area with a beautiful Boulevard; sumptuous typical bath houses and modern buildings; a magnificent port

with great infrastructure and capacity of mooring; the commercial premises of the most important marks; restaurants and pubs.

**The Beaches.** All Punta del Este beaches have transparent, crystalline waters that are excellent for bathes. Some have quiet waters and others have big waves, as well as some have thin white sands and others, thick golden sands. The first one is "Chihuahua", famous for the practice of nudism. The following one is "Solanas" which brings an excellent landscape and striking sunsets, with quiet waters. Playa Mansa which changes its depth and sand thickness in different sites. The names the different beaches have are the same names of the Inns placed along the coast. "Montoya", a deep beach of transparent waters with high waves - ideal for surfers - where youth meet in a surrounding of real charm.

La Barra. Was an old fishermen town, nowadays connected with Punta del Este by a winding bridge "Puente Ondulante", built in 1965. Here, takes place the main night-time activity of the Resort. There are important restaurants, pubs, as well as many art galleries where pieces from artists of the Rio de la Plata region are shown and sold.


